CONCORDIA CONSERVATORY'S J.P. REDMOND PRESENTS ORIGINAL FILM SCORE SCREENING OF BUSTER KEATON'S *THE HAUNTED HOUSE*

Bronxville, NY— Concordia Conservatory of Music & Art will present screening of Buster Keaton's 1921 silent film, "The Haunted House" featuring an original score by Conservatory student J.P. Redmond on Monday, July 14 at 7:00pm at Sommer Center, for Worship and the Performing Arts at Concordia College, Bronxville.

Fifteen year old Redmond studies composition and theory at Concordia Conservatory with Dr. Matt Van Brink. He has received a number of composition and piano honors. He is a recent Jack Kent Cooke Young Artist Award recipient and in September 2013 was a featured composer on National Public Radio's show *From the Top*, a non-profit organization that celebrates extraordinary young musicians by sharing their stories and performances, providing scholarships, and engaging them as leaders in national broadcasts, live concerts and outreach events across the country. Redmond has been recognized with two ASCAP Morton Gould Young Composer Awards (2014 & 2012) and awards from The Carnegie Hall Achievement Program, NYSSMA, NAFME, the National Federation of Music Clubs, Composers Concordance and Composer's Voice. In June 2014, he participated in the NYU/ASCAP Foundation Film Scoring Workshop. J.P. Redmond was born in Newport Beach, CA in 1999 and is a resident of Yonkers, NY.
