Parking Regulations:

Parking Permits

Student permits are valid for an academic year unless otherwise noted below. There will be a fee per academic year for full-time resident students if you are approved for a permit. Sophomore and First Year resident students are not permitted to have a vehicle on or off campus.

- Accelerated Degree program (Adult Ed) student parking permits are valid for the length of the program.
- Accelerated Nursing student parking permits are valid through the duration of the 15-month program.
- All other students must renew the parking permit every academic year.
- o Faculty/Staff permits are valid for as long as you are employed by Concordia.

The following regulations are in effect 24-hours a day, 7-days a week.

- 1. Anyone parking on Concordia College property must have a current "parking permit" on the rear window of the vehicle.
- 2. Only students with Resident Parking Permits may park on campus overnight.
- 3. Parking on residential streets is against school policy.
- 4. All vehicles must adhere to parking rules and regulations.
- 5. Parking permits are non-transferable, and the car registered must be owned by the student or immediate family member.
- 6. The person who registers a vehicle is responsible for assuring that the vehicle, regardless of who drives it, is parked in conformance with these regulations.
- 7. Parking permits must be clearly displayed on the exterior lower corner of the rear windshield on the driver's side
- 8. Concordia College is not responsible for theft or damage to vehicles or its content.
- 9. Spaces are limited. A parking permit does not guarantee a parking space on campus.
- 10. All students, faculty and staff must be familiar with the Concordia College's **Motor Vehicle Parking Policies and Regulations available at this link**.
- 11. Only visitors are allowed to park in the front oval in the designated visitor parking and they must have a temporary parking permit issued by the Security Office and then displayed on the front window dashboard.

Colored lines on the ground designate who may park within the parking space.

Blue Lined Spaces: Handicapped OnlyYellow Lined Spaces: Faculty/Staff/Visitors

White Lined Spaces: Faculty/Staff/Students/Visitors

Parking in the Fire Lanes (red curbing) is NOT permitted at any time.

This includes the curbs in front of Sommer Center, Rippe Hall, Romoser Hall,

Brunn-Maier Hall and Concordia Place.
